Dear Mr. Mack,

On January 5, 2017, I wrote to you to ask for assistance and or advice regarding a certified letter several of my closes neighbors and I received from Suburban Utility Company. The letter was a request for a 150 ft. Sanitary Control Easement from the center of the water plant on Danvers Drive. I also wrote to Suburban Utility Company referencing the concerns of my neighbors and myself.
