#### COMMISSION STAFF'S FINAL RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this final recommendation, and would show the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On December 27, 2016, Copano Heights Water Co. (Copano Heights) filed an application to implement a pass-through rate increase due to an increase in purchased water costs imposed on the utility by the City of Rockport. The requested effective date for the pass-through rate change is January 15, 2017.

On December 29, 2017, the administrative law judge issued a notice, which set Staff's deadline as January 17, 2016 to file its recommendation on the application, sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule.

#### II. SUFFICIENCY OF THE APPLICATION AND NOTICE

The implementation of a purchased water provision qualifies as a minor tariff change.<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to 16 Texas Admin. Code (TAC) § 24.21(h)(4), if a utility wishes to revise billings to its customers pursuant to an approved purchased water treatment or water use fee provision to allow for the recovery of additional costs, then prior to the beginning of the billing period in which the revision takes effect, the utility must submit written notice to the Commission, and give proper notice to the affected customers.<sup>2</sup>

Staff has reviewed Copano Heights' application, and based on the attached memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez of the Commission's Water Utilities Division, Staff recommends the

application be deemed complete and sufficient. The Applicant's mailed notice to affected customers on December 21, 2016, included the effective date of the increase, the present calculation of customer billings, the new calculation of customer billings, the change in charges to the utility for purchased water or water use fees, and the necessary language required by 16 TAC § 24.21(h)(4)(b). Additionally, in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.21(h)(5), the Applicant's notice to the Commission included a copy of the notice sent to customers, proof that the cost of purchased water has changed by the stated amount, and the calculation of the new rates. Thus, the Applicant has met all of the requirements set out by the Commission's substantive rules to implement the pass-through fee to affected customers.

In accordance with the attached memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez, Staff recommends that the application and notice be found sufficient, that the pass-through rates as noticed on December 21, 2016 be approved, and that a copy of the new tariff pages (attached) be provided to Copano Heights.

### III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ issue an order consistent with the above recommendation.

Pass-Through Rate Change

On December 27, 2017, Copano Heights Water Company, Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11960, filed an application to implement a pass-through rate change due to an increase in purchased water fees assessed by the City of Rockport. The pass-through rate increase will become effective on January 15, 2017.

The applicant proposed to increase the purchased water pass through rate from \$5.60 to \$5.64 per 1,000 gallons of water usage (\$0.04 pass through increase per 1,000 gallons, adjusted to reflect an 8.51% water loss). Staff confirmed that the City of Rockport has increased its rates using the documents provided with the application. Notice by the Applicant was correctly provided to the customers pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code§ 24.21(h)(4) and (5) on December 21, 2016, according to the application.

Based upon review of the information submitted, Staff finds that the application is sufficient and recommends that the commission:

- 1. Find that the application is sufficient and complete;
- 2. Approve the pass-through application as filed; and,
- 3. Provide a copy of an approve tariff to the Applicant (attached).

#### PURCHASED WATER AND/OR DISTRICT FEE PASS THROUGH CLAUSE:

Changes in fees imposed by any non-affiliated third party water supplier or underground water district having jurisdiction over the Utility shall be passed through as an adjustment to the water gallonage charge according to the following formula:

AG = G + B/(1-L), where

AG = adjusted gallonage charge, rounded to the nearest one cent;

G = approved gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons);

B = change in purchased water/district gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons);

L = system average line loss for preceding 12 month period not to exceed 15%.
