RE: Tariff Control No. 46695 – Notice of Copano Heights Water Co. for a Pass-Through Rate Change

NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice approves Copano Heights Water Co.'s application for approval to implement a pass-through rate increase due to an increase in purchased water costs imposed on the utility by the City of Rockport. The requested rate change affects all of Copano's customers. The requested effective date for the pass-through rate change is January 15, 2017.

January 17, 2017, Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed complete and sufficient and further that the application be approved; as specified in the pleading and attached memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended approval of a pass-through rate of \$5.64 per 1,000 gallons, effective January 15, 2017 for Copano's customers. Commission Staff provided revised tariff pages for Copano.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Copano's application is sufficient and it is approved. A new pass through rate of \$ 5.64 per 1,000 gallons for service rendered as of January 17, 2017 is approved. The rate change affects all of Copano's customers. Approved revised tariff pages are attached to this Notice.
