To the Honorable Public Utility Commission of Texas:

We the ratepayers who reside in the City of Howardwick hereby file with the Public Utility Commission of Texas the attached Petition of Appeal of the Red River's Authority increase in rates.

The effective date of the Red River Authority's new rates is October 1, 2016, making the Howardwick Ratepayers' Petition due no later than December 30, 2016.

We expressly ask for the Commission's Staff assistance in reviewing the Red River Authority's basis for its increase in rates, which as the attached Petition shows, if left in place, results in an increase of from about 77% to 80% in customers' water bills.

Please let me know what additional information you may need from me on this matter.

By letter dated August 31, 2016, the Red River Authority ("RRA") provided notice of its proposed increase in its rates for water and sewer service. The RRA stated its proposed rates would have an effective date of October 1, 2016 for water and sewer service. On September 21, 2016, the governing board of the RRA approved its proposed increase in rates, including approval of an effective date of October 1, 2016 for the new rates.

Pursuant to Article VI of Ordinance No. 44¹ adopted by the City of Howardwick, the RRA is to provide 60 days' notice of a proposed change in rates. The RRA provided only 30 days' notice of its change and its increase in rates.² Thus, at a minimum, the RRA has not complied with the notice requirements of Ordinance No. 44 and is precluded from implementing its increase in rates until it complies with notice requirements of Ordinance No. 44.

The undersigned ratepayers residing in the City of Howardwick, pursuant to Texas Water Code § 13.043(b) and P.U.C. Subst. Rule §§ 24.41 and 24.42, hereby appeal the September 21, 2016 decision by the governing board of the RRA to increase rates. The RRA's current rates and new rates are shown below in Table 1 and Table 2, respectively:

In addition to improper notice, the RRA has provided insufficient data to support its new rates and its rates are unreasonable in amount and design. An average consumer would see an increase of about 80% in their water bill. Because the RRA's increase in rates is unreasonable, the undersigned ratepayers request that the Public Utility Commission of Texas establish just and reasonable rates.

EXHIBIT A

ORDINANCE NO. @44

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GRANTING TO RED RIVER AUTHORITY OF TEXAS A FRANCHISE FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A WATER SYSTEM FOR THE CITY OF HOWARDWICK AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF SUCH ACTIVITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Counsel of the City of Howardwick, Texas:

1.

That the City Counsel of the City of Howardwick, Texas, does hereby grant to Red River Authority of Texas, of Wichita Falls, Wichita County, State of Texas, a franchise for the operation and maintenance of a water system for the City of Howardwick, and providing for the regulation of such activity.

ARTICLE ONE

The City of Howardwick, (hereinafter referred to as City) in the County of Donley, State of Texas, hereby grants to Red River Authority of Texas, (hereinafter referred to as Grantee) a franchise of scope and description as follows:

Grantee is hereby granted the right to conduct the business of maintaining, installing, managing, operating and running a water distribution system, to maintain and construct substations, and distribution apparatus of whatever nature that may be necessary for the purpose of operating and conducting such a business on and over the present and future streets, alleys, and public ways of the City of Howardwick, Texas, and to construct and maintain such facilities as the Grantee, its successors or assigns may deem proper under the present and future streets and alleys of said City for the purpose of such business under the following terms and restrictions:

ARTICLE TWO

The term of this grant shall be for a term of forty (40) years from the date hereof.

Grantee shall file a written acceptance of the franchise with the City Secretary of Grantor within thirty (30) days after the date of this ordinance. The franchise shall go into

effect only when this acceptance has been filed.

ARTICLE THREE

The full control of managements of the streets, alleys, and public ways within the City is expressly reserved to the City. The City reserves the right to enforce reasonable regulations concerning the construction, operation, and maintenance of facilities located along, over, or under such streets, alleys, and other public ways and the placement of such facilities.

ARTICLE FOUR

The surface of any street, alley, highway, or public place disturbed by the Grantee in building, constructing, renewing or maintaining its plant or system shall be restored within a reasonable time after the completion of the work to as good a condition as before the commencement of the work. No street, alley, highway, or public place shall be encumbered for a longer period than is necessary to execute the work.

ARTICLE FIVE

Grantee shall indemnify and defend City, its boards, commissions, officers, agents, and employees, and any and all public agencies, and their members, officers, agents, and employees, against any and all liabilities for injury to or death of any person or any damage to any property caused by Grantee, its officers, agents, or employees, in the construction, operation, or maintenance of its property, or arising out of the exercise of any right or privilege under the franchise.

ARTICLE SIX

It is mutually understood and agreed that the rates to be charged to the inhabitants of the City for water service shall be fixed and regulated by the governing body of the City in accordance with the statutes and laws of the State of Texas, the City agreeing that it will, by ordinance, enact such reasonable rates, rules, regulations, and requirements into law; provided, however, that such rates and charges

shall be sufficient to provide Grantee with a fair return upon the fair value of all its property used and useful in the furnishing of water service in the City. In the event Grantee desires to change any rate, rule, regulation, or requirement, it shall give the City sixty (60) days notice of such proposed change.

ARTICLE SEVEN

The franchise hereby given to Grantee shall be an exclusive franchise. This franchise may be forfeited if Grantee is guilty of willful violation of any of its terms and provisions.

ARTICLE EIGHT

The rights, powers, limitations, duties and restrictions herein provided for shall inure to and be binding upon the parties hereto, and on their respective successors and assigns, provided, however, that this franchise may not be assigned in whole or in part by Grantee without the written consent of the City.

ARTICLE NINE

If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be illegal, ultra vires or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. All ordinances and agreements and parts of ordinances and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE TEN

The fact that a better disbursement system of water can be afforded to the inhabitants of the City by a duly and authorized franchise operation, by reason of the City's control thereof, creates an emergency and imperative public necessity requiring the suspension of the rule that all ordinances shall be read at three meetings of the City Counsel. Said rule is therefore hereby suspended and this

ordinance is put upon its final reading and passed and adopted by a vote of _____ ayes and ____ nayes, on this the ______ day of February, 1979.

PROPOSED RATE INCREASE NOTIFICATION August 31, 2016

Dear Customer:

The Board of Directors of the Red River Authority of Texas will consider and take action on proposed rate increases for the Utility Division's water and sewer systems at its September 21, 2016 meeting. All water and sewer systems owned and operated by the Red River Authority of Texas are included in the proposed action.

During the meeting, the Board of Directors will hold a Public Hearing on the proposed rates beginning at 1:30 p.m. at the Authority's Administrative Office and Laboratory Facility located at 3000 Hammon Road in Wichita Falls, Texas. You may attend the scheduled hearing at that time and will be given an opportunity to speak, should you so desire. If the rates are adopted by the Board of Directors, they will go into effect on October 1, 2016 and will appear on your November 30, 2016 billing.

The rate adjustments are required to finance a major Bond Issue to bring the Authority's Water Systems into compliance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's Compliance Orders. In addition, as many of the water systems are reaching 50 years of age, major capital improvements are necessary to replace aging infrastructure, such as water tanks, lines, etc., to insure maximum service throughout the Authority's Utility Division.

In the past each water and sewer system has maintained its own individual system rate. The new proposed rates are based on all water and/or sewer systems combined within the Utility Division, in order to obtain the most favorable financing terms. Therefore, the proposed new rates for all water and sewer systems will be as follows:

Monthly Minimum:

\$73.50 per month with 2,000 gallons

Demand Block 1:

\$6.00 per 1,000 gallons for the next 5,000 gallons

Demand Block 2:

\$8.75 per 1,000 gallons for all water used over 7,000 gallons

Sewer Monthly Rate:

\$46.50 (only for those with sewer services)

The proposed rate is designed to provide the revenues needed to recover the cost of operating and pay the debt service. It is based on fiscal year 2015 historical financial and consumptive data without a margin for profit or return on investment. The information has been obtained from the Authority's *Comprehensive Annual Financial Report*, conducted by an independent accounting firm.

The Authority realizes that rate increases are not popular, but in order to achieve the Utility Division's basic objective of providing a safe, potable water supply capable of meeting your needs at the most economical cost, the rate increase is necessary. Therefore, the Authority urges you to conserve your use of water, be aware of leaks, and continue to support your water system.
