COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Request for Extension. In support thereof, Staff would request the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On January 3, 2017, the City of Haslet (Haslet) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12856 to provide water utility service in Tarrant County and to decertify a portion of the City of Fort Worth's service area in Tarrant County.

On March 16, 2018, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 7 which required a response from Staff regarding the requirement of TCEQ permits by April 2, 2018. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

In order to address the issues raised in Order No. 7, Staff requires more information than was provided in the application. Staff must therefore engage in additional discovery, and consequently requests that its deadline to respond to the issues raised be extended to May 3, 2018.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ extend Staff's deadline to respond to May 3, 2018.
