ORDER NO. 10 REQUIRING RESPONSE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's May 9, 2018, response to the issues raised in Order No. 7, and its motion to dismiss the City of Haslet's (Haslet) application.

On January 12, 2018, Commission Staff filed a motion to dismiss the application of the City of Haslet because it lacked the necessary water system permits from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for approval of the application.

In Order No. 7 issued on March 16, 2018, the administrative law judge required Commission Staff to confirm whether Haslet's existing public water system (PWS) has the capacity to serve the proposed development and whether the infrastructure improvements identified in Exhibit G of the development agreement are the type of improvements that require a TCEQ permit prior to approval.

On May 1, 2018, Haslet confirmed that the proposed development's number of connections exceeds that which according to TCEQ rules, would allow them to forego submitting plans and specifications to TCEQ for construction approval of their new distribution system. Commission Staff confirms that Haslet's existing public water system does not have the capacity to serve the proposed development and that a separate public water system is required.

On or before June 8, 2018, Haslet shall file a response to Commission Staff's motion to dismiss, or request withdrawal of the application under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.181(g). Failure to respond to this Order may result in dismissal of the application.
