**COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON NOTICE**

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Recommendation on Sufficiency and Procedural Schedule. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On January 5, 2017, H-M-W Special Utility District (HMWSUD) filed a petition to amend water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10342 and to decertify a portion of CCN No. 10342 in Harris County. In Order No. 5, issued June 13, 2017, Staff was ordered to file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of notice within 20 days after receiving supplemental documentation on notice from the applicant. On July 5, 2017 and July 17, 2017, HMWSUD filed additional documentation on notice. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

**II. RECOMMENDATION ON NOTICE**

Staff has reviewed HMWSUD's affidavits of notice filed on April 14, 2017, July 5, 2017 and July 17, 2017 and recommend they be found sufficient. The entities that Staff proposed be noticed in its recommendation on sufficiency filed on February 6, 2017 were noticed, as Ordered by Order No. 2, and the notice was published in a newspaper for two consecutive weeks on March 1, 2017 and March 8, 2017.

**III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Staff recommends the notice be found sufficient. Staff therefore proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for intervention	June 1, 2017
Deadline for Applicant to provide revised maps and opt out information	August 17, 2017
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on the additional mapping data and propose an additional procedural schedule	September 14, 2017

#### **IV. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above recommendation.




