**ORDER NO. 3
DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's April 20, 2017, recommendation regarding administrative completeness of this application, notice, and proposed procedural schedule. Commission Staff recommended that the application, as amended, be deemed administratively complete and that T&W Water Service Company be required to provide notice consistent with the memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the attached forms. Commission Staff recommended that T&W Water be required to submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date. Commission Staff also proposed that T&W Water produce proof of plat approval from Liberty County within a reasonable time or be subject to dismissal of this proceeding. In addition, Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is deemed sufficient and administratively complete, as amended, and T&W Water shall provide proof of plat approval from Liberty County. T&W Water shall provide notice of this application consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation and use the forms provided. The procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted.
