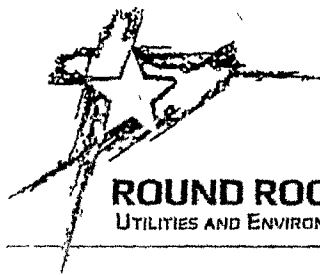

RE: City of Round Rock Wastewater CCN Amendment

Dear PUC,

This letter is in reference to the application submitted by the City of Round Rock to amend their Sewer CCN on January 11, 2017. Based on conversations with PUC, it has been determined that the submitted application should be classified as a CCN swap between the City of Round Rock and Windermere Utility Company instead of a CCN amendment.

The City of Round Rock and Windermere Utility Company both request the current application be regarded as a CCN swap between the two CCN holders per Texas Water Code Chapter 13, Section 248.

The City of Round Rock has worked with Windermere Utility Company to determine which properties can best be served by Round Rock and which properties can best be served by Windermere. This amendment to change the CCN holder for the areas referenced in the application is in the public's best interest because it will allow the properties the best opportunity for wastewater service.
