NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice addresses J&S Water Company, LLC's application to implement a passthrough rate increase due to an increase in water use fees imposed on the utility by the North Harris County Regional Water Authority. The rate increase will affect the Five Oaks subdivision (public water supply (PWS) #1011496), Maple Leaf Gardens subdivision (PWS #1011493), and Oakland Village subdivision (PWS #1010049). The requested effective date for the pass-through rate change was March 1, 2017. J&S supplemented its application on February 21, 2017.

On March 20, 2017, Commission Staff recommended that the application and notice be deemed sufficient and approved; as specified in the pleading and attached memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended approval to increase the purchase water pass-through rate from \$2.06 to \$2.76 per 1,000'gallons of water usage and provided revised tariff pages for J&S that reflect the new rate.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, J&S's application is sufficient and it is approved. A new pass through rate of \$2.76 per 1,000 gallons for service rendered as of March 1, 2017 is approved. The approved revised tariff pages are attached to this Notice.
