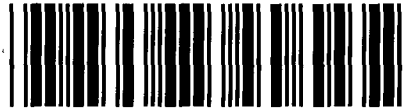


**NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT AND SETTING DEADLINES**

This Notice addresses Commission Staff's Feb 7, 2017 recommendations in this application. As specified in the pleading and attached memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez of the Commission's Water Utilities Regulation Division, Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed sufficient for further review, but requires additional information before a final recommendation can be provided. Commission Staff requested a February 15, 2017 deadline for Canyon Lake Water Supply Company to provide information regarding its projected growth rate and water loss calculation. Commission Staff also recommended that Canyon Lake be allowed to implement the \$1.15 per 1,000 gallon rate that was noticed, effective February 1, 2017.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Canyon Lake's application for a pass-through rate change is deemed sufficient. Additionally, although Canyon Lake's application is not approved in this Notice, the company is authorized to begin charging the pass-through rate of \$1.15 per 1,000 gallons that was noticed to customers, effective February 1, 2017. On or before February 15, 2017, Canyon Lake shall provide the information requested by Commission Staff in its February 7, 2017 pleading and attached memorandum. On or before February 21, 2017, Commission Staff shall provide a recommendation on final disposition or propose additional deadlines, as appropriate.
