**ORDER NO. 3  
DEEMING THE APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,  
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's April 25, 2017 recommendation on administrative completeness of the application and proposed procedural schedule. Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed administratively complete and that the applicant be required to provide notice consistent with the memorandum of Andrew Novak and Elisabeth English of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the attached forms. Commission Staff recommended that the applicant be required to submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is found administratively complete. The applicant shall provide notice of this application consistent with Commission Staff's April 25, 2017, recommendation using the forms provided. The procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted.
