APPLICANT'S PROPOSED LIST OF ISSUES

Item 15 dated June 14, 2017 on the list of docket items does not comply with the requirements of Item 9, page 6 (Notice to Neighboring Systems, Cities and Customers) of Docket No. 46782. The requirement of (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN is not addressed in the hearing request, and therefore we cannot prepare a response.

The request by the Weathersbee/Dix party should be denied.

- 2. KPOA, Inc. DBA Kamira Water System is currently under Notice of Violation (NOV) for two separate violations. The most serious, and the most difficult and expensive to solve, is for excess combined radium 226/228 and Gross Alpha in the well that supplies the Box S subdivision. When this amendment is approved, we will operate the Bracero Water Supply Corporation to serve the residents of the Kamira Subdivision, while the KPOA, dba Kamira Water System continue to serve the Box S customers and solve the NOV. Notices will be given to undeveloped lot owners and the local real estate association that Bracero WSC will not accept additional customers.
- 3. Our efforts to find a solution to the NOV (for radium^{226/228} and Gross Alpha) have been extensive. We have consulted with FMT's supplied by TCEQ. We have had commercial field technical reps visit and offer tremendously expensive solutions. The 3 engineers on the BOD of KPOA (myself included) have had hours of brainstorming in an attempt to devise a fix to a problem that many private well owners in Texas do not know exist. When this amendment is approved, we will concentrate on removing ourselves from the regulatory oversight of TCEQ, PUC and the US EPA.

ISSUES NOT TO BE ADDRESSED

None are identified at this time.
