**COMMISSION STAFF'S PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Commission Staff's Proposed Procedural Schedule. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On January 19, 2017, Kamira Property Owners Association, Inc. dba Kamira Water System (Kamira) filed an application to amend and decertify a portion of its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 12176 in Kerr County.

On August 31, 2017, the Commission issued a Preliminary Order on Threshold Issues. On September 7, 2017, State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) Order No. 3 was entered, dismissing this matter from the SOAH docket and remanding it to the Commission for further processing. On September 27, 2017, Order No. 5 was entered, requiring Staff to file a recommendation regarding a procedural schedule for continued processing by October 13, 2017. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The Preliminary Order on Threshold Issues concluded that Tex. Water Code § 13.301 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.109 (TAC) apply to the transaction proposed in this proceeding, and therefore Kamira must file a sufficient, completed form for an application for a sale, transfer, or merger.<sup>1</sup> Staff proposes the following procedural schedule for the continued processing of this docket.

Deadline for Kamira to file an application for sale, transfer, or merger	November 1, 2017
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of the application	December 11, 2017

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order adopting the above proposed procedural schedule.




