



On August 15, 2017, Jolie Mathis, PUC's Engineering Specialist, sent an email (also attached) to Victor Gutzler, Applicant's Senior Engineering Technician specifying that if the Applicant sent a signed and sealed letter from the Applicant's City Engineer stating that the extension requested to its distribution system will serve less than 10% of Applicant's existing connections per 30 TAC 290.39(j)(1)(D), then a TCEQ approval letter would not be necessary.

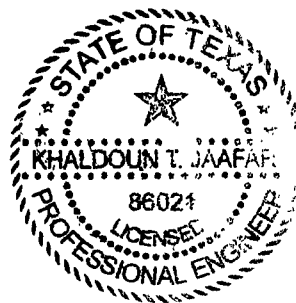

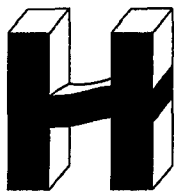
I am contacting you regarding the TCEQ requirement for specification and development plans for the provision of water service in the requested area.
