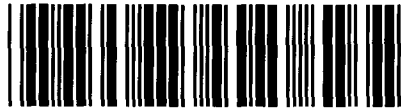


APPLICANT CITY OF FORT WORTH'S SUBMISSION OF EVIDENCE OF RECORDING OF CCN AND MAPS
