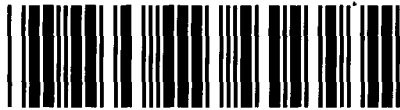

**COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON
ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Supplemental Recommendation on Administrative Completeness in response to Order No. 2 and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On January 27, 2017, the City of Fort Worth filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12311 in Tarrant County, Texas. Specifically, Fort Worth seeks to add an area of approximately 84 acres that contains no current customers to its CCN.

On February 27, 2017, Order No. 2 was issued, finding the application deficient and establishing deadlines of March 27, 2017 for Fort Worth to supplement its application and April 26, 2017 for Staff to file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and propose a procedural schedule. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Fort Worth filed supplemental information on April 25, 2017. Staff requires additional time to review the supplemental materials and is unable to make a recommendation on administrative completeness at this time. Staff therefore requests that a deadline of May 26, 2017

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be established for Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of Fort Worth's application.

III. CONCLUSION




