## ORDER NO. 3 FINDING THE APPLICATION DEFICIENT; GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation on administrative completeness and the City of Princeton's request for extension. On March 30, 2017, Commission Staff recommended the application be found administratively incomplete and deficient. On April 7, 2017, the City of Princeton filed a response to Order No. 2 and requested a 30-day extension to propose a procedural schedule.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. In accordance with 16 Texas Admin. Code § 24.8(d), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made so, at this time, the application is not considered filed with the Commission

The City of Princeton's request for a 30-day extension to propose a procedural schedule is granted. On or before May 8, 2017, the parties shall propose a procedural schedule, including deadlines to cure the deficiencies and for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation.
