## ORDER NO. 8 APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation regarding completeness of the City of Princeton's application. Commission Staff stated that the application remains administratively incomplete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's pleadings and memorandum of Janie Kohl in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Princeton's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. Applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made;<sup>1</sup> therefore, at this time, this application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before December 1, 2017, Princeton shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before December 29, 2017, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on the application.
