STAFF'S MOTION TO ABATE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this motion to abate:

On February 6, 2017, the City of Princeton (Princeton) filed an application to amend water certificate of convenience and necessity No. 13195 and sewer CCN No. 21057 and to decertify a portion of Altoga Water Supply Corporation (Altoga) in Collin County. However, Altoga filed an application to transfer its water CCN to North Collin Special Utility District in Docket No. 46452 on October 18, 2016. As it is unclear which utility will possess a CCN for the area Princeton seeks decertify in this case, Princeton's request is not ripe for review. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests the Administrative Law Judge abate the present proceeding until ninety days after a final order has been issued in Docket No. 46452.
