NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT; REQUIRING REVISED NOTICE AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES

This Notice addresses Commission Staff's March 1, 2017 recommendation that this application be found deficient, as specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez of the Commission's Water Utilities Regulation Division. Commission Staff stated that the notice of the proposed rate change provided to affected ratepayers by The Commons Water Supply, Inc. did not identify the correct public water system. Commission Staff recommended that approval of The Commons' application be delayed for two weeks, until after corrected notice is provided to customers, and that within two weeks of this Notice, The Commons file a copy of the revised notice provided to its customers.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, The Commons' application is deficient, and The Commons is provided an opportunity to cure the deficiencies. The Commons shall provide corrected notice of the proposed rate change to affected customers. On or before March 21, 2017, The Commons shall file proof with the Commission that corrected notice has been provided; including an affidavit attesting to the provision of corrected notice to customers, with a copy of the actual notice provided attached. On or before March 31, 2017, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and propose additional deadlines, as appropriate.
