ORDER NO. 7 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's September 15, 2017, recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application, provision of notice, and a proposed procedural schedule. Commission Staff recommended that the application be found administratively complete and that Water Necessities, Inc. be required to provide notice consistent with the memorandum of Patricia Garcia of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the forms attached to the memorandum. Commission Staff recommended that Water Necessities be required to submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, including publisher's affidavits, along with a copy of the actual notices issued. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of the application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is administratively complete. Water Necessities shall provide notice of the application consistent with Commission Staff's September 15, 2017, recommendation, using the forms provided with the recommendation. Commission Staff's proposed procedural schedule is adopted as follows:

Event	Date
Deadline for Water Necessities to file signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	October 30, 2017
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of Water Necessities filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
