ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation of March 15, 2017, regarding administrative completeness of Water Necessities, Inc.'s application. Commission Staff recommended that the application be found administratively incomplete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's filing and attached memorandum of Patricia Garcia of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Water Necessities' application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. In accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d) (TAC), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made. At this time, the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before April 14, 2017, applicant shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before May 15, 2017, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if deemed administratively complete.
