**COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Request for Extension of Time. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On February 17, 2017, Patricia Miller Deason (Deason) filed a petition (Petition) with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) for expedited release of 257.86 acres (Property) from Marilee Special Utility District's (Marilee) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10150 in Collin County, Texas, pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 13.254(a-5) (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.113(r) (TAC).<sup>1</sup> Deason asserts that the Property is not receiving water service from Marilee.<sup>2</sup>

In Order No. 3, issued March 22, 2017, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) deemed the Petition administratively complete and ordered Staff to file a recommendation on final disposition by April 5, 2017. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**II. STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Deason filed a Reply to Marilee's Response on March 31, 2017. Marilee filed a Response to Deason's Reply on April 4, 2017. Staff requests an extension so that Staff may consider whether the recently filed information will affect its

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recommendation. Therefore, Staff requests that the ALJ find good cause to extend Staff's deadline to file a recommendation to April 10, 2017.

For the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending Staff's deadline to file its recommendation to April 10, 2017.


