ORDER NO. 4 REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS OF AMENDED PETITION

This Order addresses Commission Staff's April 5 2017 request for a new procedural schedule, based on Celina Partners, Ltd.'s April 4, 2017 amendment to the petition. Commission Staff stated that due to the amendment, Staff will need to file new comments on administrative completeness. Commission Staff requested a new procedural schedule setting forth a deadline for a recommendation on administrative completeness of the amended petition.

Commission Staff's request is granted. On or before May 4, 2017, Commission Staff shall file comments on the administrative completeness of the amended petition and notice.¹ The 60th day² for the amended petition will be calculated based on the date an order is issued deeming the amended petition administratively complete.
