COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Request for Extension. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 17, 2017, Legacy Stables, LLC (Legacy) filed a petition (Petition) with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) for expedited release of 71.71 acres from Marilee Special Utility District's (Marilee) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10150 in Collin County, Texas, pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 13.254(a-5) (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.113(r) (TAC).¹ Legacy asserts that the Property is not receiving water service from Marilee.²

In Order No. 3, issued March 22, 2017, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) deemed the Petition administratively complete and ordered Staff to file a recommendation on final disposition by April 4, 2017. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Legacy has informed Staff that it intends to amend its Petition. Staff requests an extension so that Staff may consider whether the information will affect its recommendation. Therefore, Staff requests that the ALJ find good cause to extend Staff's deadline to file a recommendation to April 7, 2017.
