

**ORDER NO. 4
REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS OF
AMENDED PETITION**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's April 4, 2017 request for an extension of time to file its recommendation on final disposition in this petition. Commission Staff's stated that Legacy Stables, LLC indicated it intended to amend the petition. Therefore, Commission Staff requested time to consider whether the information will affect its recommendation. However, in its April 4, 2017 response to Marilee Special Utility District's response to the petition, Legacy amended the petition to exclude 1.44 acres. Therefore, rather than extending deadlines, a new procedural schedule is appropriate in this petition.

On or before May 4, 2017, Commission Staff shall file comments on the administrative completeness of the amended petition and notice.¹ The 60th day² for the amended petition will be calculated based on the date an order is issued deeming the amended petition administratively complete.
