

COMMISSION STAFF'S AMENDED SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Amended Supplemental Recommendation on Administrative Completeness in response to Order No. 2 and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On March 15, 2017, Vineyard Ridge, LLC (Vineyard Ridge) filed an application to obtain a water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Gillespie County. On May 3, 2017, Vineyard Ridge supplemented its application.

On June 21, 2017, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 3 which found Vineyard Ridge's application administratively complete pursuant to Staff's recommendation on June 16, 2017 supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness. Staff now files this amended recommendation to correct an error in the attached notices.

II. COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed Vineyard Ridge's petition and supplement, and, as supported by the attached memorandum of Fred Bednarski of the Water Utilities Division, Staff still recommends that the application be found administratively complete and deemed sufficient for filing.

III. NOTICE REQUIREMENTS

In its original recommendation, Staff included a notice that inadvertently understated the size of the area to be certificated. Staff has attached a corrected notice that the Applicants must

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provide to any districts, utilities, and cities within two miles of the proposed service area, the county judge of Gillespie County, each groundwater conservation district and city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified. In addition to those systems identified in the Application, Staff recommends that Applicants notify the entities identified in the attached memorandum.

Further, Staff has attached the affidavit the Applicants must sign and file with the Commission after providing notice in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.112(c). Additionally, the Applicants should provide an accurate map delineating the proposed area with each mailed notice. Staff recommends that Applicants publish notice once each week for two consecutive weeks in newspapers of general circulation in Gillespie County.

At this time, Staff recommends that the Applicants be allowed to proceed with providing notice for the proposed transaction and be given until July 17, 2017 to provide proof of notice to the Commission.

It is recommended that the Applicant use the attached notice and affidavits to meet these requirements.

IV. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes no changes to the procedural schedule.

V. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the issuance of an order consistent with the above recommendation.

On March 15, 2017, Vineyard Ridge, LLC, (Applicant) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to obtain a water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Gillespie County, Texas pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann. (TWC), §§ 13.242 to 13.250 and the 16 Tex. Admin Code (TAC) §§ 24.101 to 24.107.

On June 7, 2017, Staff recommended the application be deemed sufficient for filing and for the Applicant to provide notice. Staff has since reviewed the application and determined the acreage on the notice should be approximately 660 acres. Therefore Staff recommends the Applicant use the following revised notices and affidavits to meet the notice requirements.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CCN) TO PROVIDE WATER UTILITY SERVICE IN GILLESPIE COUNTY, TEXAS

Vineyard Ridge, LLC, has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to obtain a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for the provision of retail water utility service in Gillespie County.

The requested area is located approximately <u>14 miles northeast of downtown Fredericksburg</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>North Grape Creek Road</u>; on the east by <u>North Grape Creek Road</u> on the south by <u>FM 2721</u>; and on the west by <u>Dry Hollow Road (CR 109)</u>.

The total requested area includes approximately 660 acres and 0 current customers.

You may request a public hearing. A request for a public hearing must be in writing and include: (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the Utility name, docket number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Hearing requests, comments or requests to intervene should be filed with the:

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written request will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for a final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt out") within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility.

All opt out requests must include a large scale map and a metes and bounds description of the landowner's tract of land.

Persons who wish to request this option should file the required documents with the:

In addition, the landowner must also send a copy of the opt out request to the Utility. Staff may request additional information regarding your request.

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
