




APPLICATION OF VINEYARD RIDGE LLC FOR A WATER CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IN GILLESPIE COUNTY

On September 14, 2017, Vineyard Ridges, LLC (VR) filed a request to reconsider PUC Order No. 6, arguing that John McCrae did not have standing to protest the Application and seeking to have the Commission's referral to SOAH rescinded. Mr. McCrae filed a response opposing the motion on September 21, 2017. Staff did not file a response.

On August 11, 2017, Mr. McCrae filed a motion to intervene and requested a public hearing. No objection was filed regarding the motion to intervene. On August 29, 2017, the Commission's administrative law judge granted the motion to intervene. This case was referred to SOAH on August 30, 2017.

The ALJ will not consider or rule on VR's motion because it seeks reconsideration of a Commission order, not a SOAH order. The ALJ is issuing this letter to alert the parties and the Commission of the status of the motion, and to allow the Commission to take further action as it sees fit.
