## COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Supplemental Recommendation on Sufficiency. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

### I. BACKGROUND

On April 20, 2017, Dogwood Estates Water Company (Dogwood) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application for a rate/tariff change (Application) under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10823 in Henderson County. On June 7, 2017 and August 7, 2017, Dogwood filed supplemental information to their Application.

Order No. 3 was issued by the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) on July 25, 2017, requiring Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the amended Application by August 18, 2017. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

## II. STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed the Application and, based on the attached memorandum of Janie Kohl of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff recommends that the Application and notice be deemed sufficient for filing and administratively complete.

Deadline for Applicant to respond to Staff's final recommendation	January 17, 2018
Deadline for Commission to refer to SOAH for hearing (120 days from September 22, 2017 effective date <sup>2</sup> )	January 20, 2017

On April 20, 2017, Dogwood Estates Water Company (Applicant) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) for a rate/tariff change affecting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10823 in Henderson County.
