ORDER NO. 3 DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's April 24, 2017 recommendation. Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed administratively complete and that Lil Countryside WSC be required to provide notice consistent with the memorandum of Andrew Novak of the Commission's Water Utility Regulatory Division, using the attached forms. Commission Staff recommended that Lil Countryside WSC be required to submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is deemed sufficient and administratively complete. Lil Countryside WSC shall provide notice of this application consistent with Commission Staff's April 24, 2017, recommendation and use the forms provided. The procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted.
