UNDINE TEXAS, LLC'S RESPONSE TO COMMISSION STAFF'S ORDER NO. 4

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

Undine Texas, LLC ("Undine") files this Response to Order No. 4. In support thereof, Undine states the following:

I. Background

On March 27, 2017, Undine filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission") an application for sale, transfer, or merger of a retail public utility in Johnson and Tarrant Counties. On April 27, 2017, Commission Staff filed its First Administrative Completeness Recommendation. On May 1, 2017, the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") filed Order No. 2 finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Establishing Deadlines and Opportunity to Cure. On May 18, 2017, Undine filed its Response to Commission Staff's Order No. 2. On May 19, 2017, Commission Staff filed a Request for Extension. On May 22, 2017, the ALJ issued Order No. 3 Extending Deadlines. On June 23, 2017, Commission Staff filed its Second Administrative Completeness Recommendation. On June 28, 2017, the ALJ issued Order No. 4, finding that Undine's application is still deficient and not administratively complete and directing the applicant to amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff on or before July 21, 2017. Accordingly, this response is timely filed.

II. Supplemental Application Information Provided

In response to Commission Staff Order No. 4, Undine hereby files the following information.

Deficiency - Mapping

The revised maps submitted still do not comply with Commission requirements.

Response:

Attached as <u>Exhibit A</u> is the supplemental mapping, including the digital data. Based on a meeting between the Applicant and Commission Staff, it is Applicant's understanding that this supplemental mapping satisfies Commission Staff's request.

Deficiency – Decertification

The revised mapping documentation shows overlaps with portions of the certificated service areas of the City of Cleburne (CCN No. 10917), Johnson County SUD (CCN No. 10081), and Monarch Utilities I LP (CCN No. 12983). If it is the Applicants intent to seek that these areas be included in the STM, then Applicants must file signed agreements from those entities which indicate that they agree to the decertification of a portion of their respective service areas. Along with such signed agreements, the Applicant must also clarify whether any existing customers would be changing water service providers in the areas being decertified from the existing certificate holders.

Response:

Attached as <u>Exhibit B</u> is the signed agreement between the Applicant and Monarch Utilities I LP. Undine has been working diligently with Johnson County SUD and the City of Cleburne to obtain a signed agreement with those two entities, and will supplement this response with those agreements as soon as Undine receives those agreements.

Regarding the requirement that Applicant clarify whether any existing customers would be changing water service providers in the areas being decertified from the existing certificate holders, the existing customers will become customers of Undine.

Other - Operational Staff Information

Staff continues to note that although not required for completion of the administrative completeness phase, the Applicants must ultimately provide a list of licensed operational staff that will be hired to operate the proposed areas.

Response:

Undine recognizes its obligation to provide a list of licensed operational staff and will be prepared to provide it at the appropriate time.

III. Conclusion

Undine respectfully submits this information in support of its application. Undine is prepared to supplement this submittal with the two additional agreements as soon as those become available. Accordingly, Undine requests a reasonable extension to allow it time to finalize and submit those agreements.



Chuck Bull and Undree have submitted an application to the Public Unlay Commission of Toward ("PUC") for the calc of certain facility and certificate rights from Chuck Bull to Undine (the "Application"). Based on our review, the Application includes an area of overlap with Monarch Utility I LP's ("Monarch") CCN No. 12983. The attacked maps specify, in yellow highlighting, the area of overlap.

This letter requests that Monarch agree to descrify the area highlighted on the attached maps from its CCN 12983 so that Chuck Bell and Undine may incorporate those areas into the service areas that are otherwise the subject of the Application. We note that Monarch does not now, nor has it ever, supplied drinking water service to customers within the area highlighted on the attached maps. Undine and Chuck Bell seek Monarch's descriptional of the area for no compensation under Texas Water Code § 13 254

If approved, the decertification will allow Undine to exercise its authority to provide retail, public water and sewer utility service under Undine's STM Application to the portion of Monarch's CCN No. 12983 requested for decertification.


