ORDER NO. 7 APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT; ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's December 1, 2017 recommendation that the application of Chuck Bell dba Chuck Bell Water System, LLC and Undine Texas, LLC for the sale, transfer or merger of facilities and certificate right in Johnson and Tarrant Counties remains deficient and not administratively complete, as specified in Commission Staff's pleading. Applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time this application is not considered filed with the Commission.

Commission Staff stated that applicants failed to provide required information to complete the application by the deadline established in Order No. 6. Commission Staff proposed deadlines for Chuck Bell and Undine to supplement the application and for a further recommendation on administrative completeness by Commission Staff.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before January 19, 2018, applicants shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Failure to amend the application as required may result in dismissal. On or before February 9, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and propose additional deadlines, as appropriate.
