Implement a Pass-Through Rate Change

#### NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice addresses Nerro Supply Investors, LLC's application to implement a pass-through rate change due to water use fees imposed on the utility by the North Harris County Regional Water Authority (NHCRWA). The rate increase affects the Spring Creek Valley Estates subdivision, public water system #1010213. The requested effective date for the pass-through rate change was April 1, 2017.

On April 19, 2017, Commission Staff recommended that Nerro's application and notice be deemed administratively complete and further that the application be approved; as specified in the pleading and attached memorandum of Andrew Novak of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff requested issuance of a notice finding the application administratively complete and approving an \$0.84 increase in the NHCWRA pass-through rate for affected customers, from \$2.19 to \$3.03 per 1,000 gallons, effective April 1, 2017. Commission Staff provided revised tariff pages for Nerro.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Nerro's application, is sufficient and it is approved. A pass-through rate of \$3.03 per 1,000 gallons is approved for Nerro's customers in the Spring Creek Valley Estates subdivision, effective April 1, 2017. The approved revised tariff pages are attached to this Notice.

ABR = adjusted base rate, rounded to nearest one cent;

B = approved gallonage charge, per 1,000 gallons;.

L = water or sewer line loss for preceding 12 months, not to exceed 0.15 (15%)
