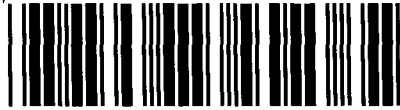

Notice is given to the public of the filing with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (commission) of an application to amend water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Williamson County, Texas.

Docket Style and Number: Application of Aqua Utilities, Inc. and City of Georgetown for Approval of Service Area Contract under Texas Water Code §13.248 and to Amend Certificates of Convenience and Necessity in Williamson County, Docket Number 47008.

The Application: Aqua Utilities, Inc. dba Aqua Texas and the City of Georgetown seek approval of an agreement that would amend their water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Williamson County. Aqua holds water CCN No. 11157 and the City holds water CCN No. 12369. Aqua and the City have agreed to amend their respective water CCNs to transfer certain certificated service areas from the City's water CCN No. 12369 to Aqua's CCN NO. 11157 so that Aqua may provide retail water service to the proposed San-Gabriel Hidden Creek Estates subdivision. The application includes a map depicting the existing certificated areas of applicants and copy of the service agreement between the parties.

Aqua and Hidden Creek agree that Aqua will provide retail water service to the proposed transfer area and Georgetown agrees to transfer the proposed transfer area to Aqua within the terms of the contract. No city facilities or customers are currently located in the area proposed for transfer.
