ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's May 1, 2017 recommendation on administrative completeness of Utopia Water Supply Corporation's application. Commission Staff recommended the application be found deficient for the reasons specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Andrew Novak, Gary Horton and Sean Scaff of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that the Utopia WSC be provided an opportunity to cure the deficiencies and proposed deadlines for continued processing of the application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation the Utopia WSC's application is found to be deficient. Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made;¹ thus, at this time the Utopia WSC's application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before May 26, 2017, the Utopia WSC shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before June 9, 2017, Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental recommendation on the amended application.
