STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Supplemental Recommendation on Administrative Completeness. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On April 4, 2017, Aqua Water Supply Corporation (Aqua) and Fayette Water Supply Corporation (Fayette) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of a sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Bastrop County. Specifically, Aqua and Fayette have agreed to transfer a portion of Aqua's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10294 to Fayette's water CCN No. 10726 to allow Fayette to provide water service to residents who are currently without potable water service.

On July 5, 2017, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 3, which established August 28, 2017 as the deadline for Staff to file a supplemental recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the application and to propose a procedural schedule. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the application and supplemental materials and, as supported by the attached memorandum from Jolie Mathis of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff recommends that the application be deemed administratively complete and accepted for filing. Staff further recommends that the Applicants be required to provide notice consistent with the recommendations in the attached memorandum.

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III. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 4, 2017, Fayette Water Supply Corporation (Fayette WSC or Buyer) and the Aqua Water Supply Corporation (Aqua WSC or Seller) (Collectively, Applicants) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger (STM) of certificate rights in Bastrop County, Texas, pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann. (TWC) § 13.301 and the 16 Tex. Admin Code (TAC) § 24.109. Specifically, Fayette WSC, Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10726, seeks to transfer a portion of Aqua WSC's water service area under CCN No. 10294. The requested area includes approximately 2035 acres and 0 connections.

On July 6, 2017, the Applicants filed information in response to Commission Order No. 3. Staff has reviewed the information and recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for filing and administratively complete. Staff further recommends the Applicant be ordered to do the following:

- 1) Provide notice of the application to the following:
 - a) any districts, utilities, and cities within two (2) miles of the requested area;
 - b) the county judge of each county and each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the requested area to be certified;
 - c) each city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) that is wholly or partly included in the requested area to be certified;
- 2) Provide correct notice of the application to the following entities:
 - Fayette WSC (CCN No. 10726)
 - Fayette County Groundwater Conservation District (GCD)
 - Lost Pines GCD
 - Lower Colorado River Authority
 - Bastrop County Judge
- 3) Include copy of a map showing the requested area with the individual notices to neighboring utilities and other affected parties. It is the Applicant's burden to provide an accurate map delineating the requested area with each individual notice. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained from the TCEQ's web site located at http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/.

Within 30 days of the Commission order, the Applicant should file a copy of the actual notice and map issued, along with a signed affidavit indicating that the notice was given. It is recommended that the Applicant use the attached notice and affidavit to meet these requirements.

A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-332, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
