ORDER NO. 6  
APPROVING SALE/TRANSFER TO PROCEED

This Order addresses Commission Staff's November 15, 2017, recommendation that the transaction proposed in this application be allowed to proceed.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation the transaction proposed in this application may proceed and be consummated. As soon as possible after the effective date of the transaction, but not later than 30 days after, Aqua Water Supply Corporation and Fayette Water Supply Corporation (collectively, applicants) shall file proof that the transaction has been consummated and customer deposits have been properly addressed.<sup>1</sup> Applicants have 180 days to complete the transaction.<sup>2</sup> If the transaction is not consummated within this period, the approval is void, unless the Commission in writing extends the time period for good cause shown.<sup>3</sup> Applicants are advised that the certificate affected by this application will continue to be held by Aqua WSC until this application is complete in accordance with the Commission's rules and final approval is issued.

In an effort to finalize this case as soon as possible, beginning December 15, 2017, and continuing monthly thereafter, the applicants shall file an update regarding the status of the efforts to conclude the transaction and submit documents evidencing the transaction was consummated and customer deposits properly addressed.

Within 15 days following the filing of the applicants' proof that the sale/transfer has been consummated and customer deposits (if any) have been addressed, Commission Staff shall file a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the documents and propose a schedule for the continued processing of this docket.
