ORDER NO. 4 DEEMING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's June 7, 2017, recommendation that the petition of Jeff Stockton is administratively complete and sufficient for further review. Commission Staff suggested that this docket should not be processed under the new rules for streamlined expedited releases.¹

Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made.² Therefore, this application is considered filed the date this order is signed and the new rules for streamlined expedited releases shall apply. Under the new rules, a final order in this docket must identify what property, if any, is useless or valueless property.³
