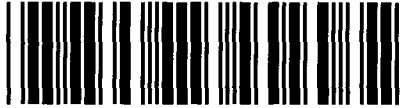

**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's May 11, 2017, recommendation on the administrative completeness of Concho Rural Water Corporation's application. Commission Staff recommended the application be found deficient for the reasons specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that the Concho Rural be provided an opportunity to cure the deficiencies and proposed deadlines for continued processing of the application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation the application is found to be deficient. Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made;¹ thus, at this time the Concho Rural's application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before June 9, 2017, the Concho Rural shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before June 23, 2017, Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental recommendation on the amended application.
