ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's May 18, 2017 recommendations in this application. Commission Staff recommended the application be found deficient, for the reasons specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Greg Charles of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that the Quadvest, L.P. be provided an opportunity to cure the deficiencies and proposed deadlines for continued processing of the application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation the Quadvest's application is found deficient, administratively incomplete. Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made;¹ thus, at this time Quadvest's application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **June 19, 2017**, Quadvest shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before July 19, 2017, Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application.
