**ORDER NO. 4
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING
SCHEDULE FOR CONTINUED PROCESSING**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation on notice and proposed procedural schedule. Commission Staff stated that on July 31, 2017, applicants filed affidavits of proof of notice to current customers, neighboring systems, and cities. Notice was completed on July 28, 2017, therefore, the 120-day deadline to approve the sale administratively or require a public hearing is November 27, 2017. Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule based on that deadline.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the notice is sufficient. The following procedural schedule shall apply:

Deadline for intervention	August 28, 2017 ¹
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval of the sale and on issuance of certificate	September 28, 2017
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation	October 12, 2017
120-day deadline for Commission to approval the sale or require a hearing	November 27, 2017 ²


¹ 16 TAC § 24.109(b). The 30th day is Sunday, August 27, 2017. Thus, under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4 the period shall conclude on the end of the next day on which the Commission is open for business

² The 120th day is Saturday, November 25, 2017. Therefore, the period shall conclude on the end of the next day on which the Commission is open for business.
