#### COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Supplemental Recommendation on Administrative Completeness in Response to Order No. 2 and would show the following:

#### I. **BACKGROUND**

On May 1, 2017, Parker Creek Estates LP (Parker Creek) and the City of Royse City (City) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Rockwall County, Texas. Specifically, the City seeks to acquire all of Parker Creek's facilities and certificate rights under water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 13071 and sewer CCN No. 20968. Parker Creek filed supplements to its application on July 6, 2017, and July 10, 2017.

On June 5, 2017, Order No. 2 was issued, establishing a deadline of August 4, 2017 for Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and notice and propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the application. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

#### II. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

As detailed in the attached memorandum from Debbie Reyes Tamayo in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff has reviewed the application and supplemental information filed by Parker Creek, and recommends that it be found administratively complete.

### III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends the application be found administratively complete. Staff therefore proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued

On May 1, 2017, City of Royse City (Royse City or Buyer), CCN Nos. 12827 and 20813 and Parker Creek Estates, LP (Parker Creek or Seller), CCN Nos. 13071 and 20968, (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for the Sale, Transfer, or Merger (STM) of facilities and certificate rights in Rockwell County, Texas, pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann. (TWC) § 13.301 and 16 Tex. Admin Code (TAC) § 24.109. Specifically, Royse City seeks approval to acquire all of Park Creek Estates, LP's facilities and service area and to cancel Parker Creek's CCN Nos. 13071 and 20968.

Staff has reviewed the information provided and recommends that the application be deemed administratively complete and sufficient for filing. Staff recommends the Applicants be directed to provide notice as described below.

- 1) The Applicants should provide notice to the following:
  - a. any districts, utilities, and cities within two (2) miles of the requested area;
  - b. the county judge of each county and each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the requested area to be certified;
  - c. each city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) that is wholly or partly included in the requested area to be certified;
  - d. any customers transferred, or other affected parties in the requested area.
- 2) The Applicant must also notice the following:
  - BHP WSC (CCN No. 10064)
  - Blackland WSC (CCN No. 11305)
  - Cash SUD (CCN No. 10824)
  - City of Fate (CCN Nos. 12889 and 20856)
  - North Texas MWD
  - Parker Creek MUD
  - Rockwall County Judge
  - Rockwall County MUD 7

The Applicants should include a map showing the proposed service area with the individual notices to neighboring utilities and other affected parties. It is the Applicant's burden to provide an accurate map delineating the proposed area with each individual notice. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained by the Applicant from the TCEQ web site located at <a href="http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/">http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/</a>.

Within 30 days of the Commission order, Staff recommends that the Applicants be required to file a copy of the actual individual notice sent with attached signed and notarized affidavit that the notice was given.

#### Parker Creek Estates

The area subject to this transaction is located approximately 3 miles south of downtown Royse City, Texas and is generally bounded on the north by FM 548 and Crenshaw Road; on the east by Crenshaw Road; on the south by Parker Creek and on the west by FM 548 and Parker Creek.

The total <u>water service area</u> being requested includes approximately <u>200</u> acres and serves <u>0</u> current customers.

The total <u>sewer service area</u> being requested included approximately  $\underline{310}$  acres and serves  $\underline{0}$  current customers.

This transaction will have the following effect on the current customers' rates and services:

There are no current customers, however future customers will be charged City of Royse City water and sewer rates.

You may request a public hearing. A request for a public hearing must be in writing and include: (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, docket number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Hearing requests, comments or requests to intervene should be filed with the:

Public Utility Commission of Texas Central Records 1701 North Congress Avenue P.O. Box 13326 Austin, Texas 78711-3326 within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
