## ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

### I. Application

This Order addresses Commission Staff's June 1, 2017, recommendation that the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's pleading and the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo in the Commission's Water Utilities Regulation Division. Commission Staff also proposed deadlines for applicants to complete the application and for a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. Applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made;<sup>1</sup> thus, at this time this application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **July 6, 2017**, applicants shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before August 4, 2017, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule if appropriate.
