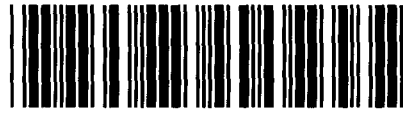

JOINT SUPPLEMENTAL MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE

COME NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest; Blackland Water Supply Corporation (Blackland); and the City of Royse City (City) and file this Joint Supplemental Motion to Admit Evidence and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 1, 2017, Blackland Water Supply Corporation (Blackland) and the City of Royse City (City) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Rockwall County, Texas. Specifically, the City seeks to acquire a portion of Blackland’s facilities and certificate rights under water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11305.

On April 12, 2018, Blackland filed a consent form consenting to the final map and certificates in this proceeding. On April 24, 2018, the parties filed a Joint Proposed Notice of Approval and Request to Admit Evidence, which included consent forms and the final map and certificates in the list of evidence requested to be admitted. On April 27, 2018, Order No. 7 was issued, admitting evidence into the proceeding. Blackland’s consent form was included in the list of evidence admitted by Order No. 7.

II. REQUEST TO ADMIT EVIDENCE

On May 3, 2018, the City filed its signed consent form. The parties hereby request that the City’s consent form and all attachments be admitted into the evidentiary record of this proceeding.

III. CONCLUSION


As detailed above, the parties hereby request that the City’s consent form and all attachments be admitted into the record.


