**ORDER NO. 2**

**FINDING THE PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,  
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES FOR OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's June 1, 2017 recommendations regarding II C.B., LP's petition and notice. Commission Staff recommended the petition be deemed administratively incomplete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in the memorandum of Patricia Garcia of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff also proposed deadlines that provide II C.B. an opportunity to cure the deficiencies and for Commission Staff to provide a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the petition is found administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(a), petitions are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the petition is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before July 3, 2017, the applicant shall amend the petition to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the petition cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before August 3, 2017, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
