NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND WATER CERTIFICATES OF CONVENIENCE  
AND NECESSITY AND FOR APPROVAL OF A SERVICE AREA CONTRACT

Notice is given to the public of the filing with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (commission) of an application to amend water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Bastrop County.

Docket Style and Number: Application of Aqua Water Supply Corporation and City of Smithville for Approval of a Service Area Contract Under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to Amend Certificates of Convenience and Necessity in Bastrop County, Docket Number 47173.

The Application: Aqua Water Supply Corporation and the City of Smithville seek approval of an agreement that would amend their water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Bastrop County pursuant to Texas Water Code § 13.248.

Aqua holds water CCN No. 10294 and the City holds water CCN No. 10946. Aqua and the City have agreed to amend their respective water CCNs to transfer certain certificated service areas from Aqua's CCN No. 10294 to the City's CCN No. 10946. The total area being requested includes approximately 907 acres. Aqua agrees to decertification of the proposed water service transfer area as described in the application. The application includes a map depicting the existing certificated areas of applicants, the proposed transfer area, and copy of the service agreement between the parties.
