This Order addresses Commission Staff's June 16, 2017, recommendation on the administrative completeness of Aqua Water Supply Corporation and the City of Smithville's application. Commission Staff recommended the application be found deficient for the reasons specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Leila Guerrero of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that applicants be required to file revised maps and digital data for continued processing of the application.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation the application is found to be deficient. Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time Aqua and Smithville's application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before July 11, 2017, Aqua and Smithville shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before August 10, 2017, Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental recommendation on the amended application.
