**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation filed on June 16, 2017. Commission Staff reviewed Liberty Utilities Corp.'s application for administrative completeness and recommended that the application be found deficient and administratively incomplete because it contains material deficiencies. In order to cure the deficiencies, Commission Staff requested that Liberty provide the more recent 2017 TCEQ inspection report, the notarized oath on page 12 of the application, and clarify the number of current customers in the requested area.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before July 17, 2017, applicant shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before August 17, 2017, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
