**ORDER OF REFERRAL**

The Public Utility Commission of Texas refers this docket to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) and requests the assignment of an administrative law judge (ALJ) to conduct a hearing and issue a proposal for decision, if necessary, to resolve any issues that are contested by the parties.

Under Commission rules, if the Commission receives a petition for review from the lesser of 10,000 or 10% of the ratepayers of the utility whose rates have been changed and who are eligible to appeal, or on its own motion, the Commission shall set the matter for hearing.<sup>1</sup> It appears that over 10% of the eligible ratepayers have filed protests to appeal the rates. In addition, Commission Staff has requested a hearing on this matter.

In order to develop a list of the issues to be addressed in this docket, as well as any necessary statement of Commission policy, precedent, or position on any threshold legal or policy issues relevant to this proceeding Ratepayers of Kempner Water Supply Corporation and Kempner Water Supply Corporation, shall, and the Commission Staff and any other interested party may, file with the Commission a list of issues to be addressed in the docket by **July 6, 2016**. This pleading may also identify any issues that should not be addressed in the docket, and identify any threshold legal and policy issues that should be briefed for purposes of a preliminary order. Specific explanations should support any such issues identified in the pleading. Parties shall not file responses to any pleading submitted in response to this Order, unless specifically requested.

All subsequent pleadings in this docket must contain both the SOAH and PUC docket numbers to allow for efficient processing. Parties shall make filings in accordance with 16 Texas



The Commission will issue and provide to SOAH a preliminary order that includes a list of issues and areas that must be addressed in this proceeding, as required by Texas Government Code § 2003.049(e) and any necessary statement of Commission policy, precedent, or position on threshold issues, or combination thereof, relevant to this proceeding, as required by Texas Government Code § 2001.058(c). The Commission will consider and possibly adopt a preliminary order in this docket in the open meeting currently scheduled to convene on **July 28, 2016**.
